



THE AUSTRALIAN SCHOOL OF THE YEAR SCHOLARSHIP 2010

The *Australian Newspaper*, *Wooldridges* and *Nell Gray Manufacturing* have offered to sponsor this scholarship which commemorates our success in being named the inaugural **Australian School of the Year** in 2001. The scholarship is open to all current (2009) Year 7 students who are living and will continue to live with their parents in our local intake area. Applicants will be short listed based upon an assessment of their performance by their current primary school. To be considered for the scholarship, students will need to have demonstrated a high level of achievement across a number of learning areas in their primary school studies.

Applicants may be required to have an interview with the Principal and/or his nominees as part of the selection process. Applicants are advised to bring a portfolio of their Year 7 work, the latest school report, NAPLAN report and acknowledgements of outstanding performance with them to such an interview. The winner of the scholarship will be announced in Term 4, 2009.

The winner of the **Australian School of the Year Scholarship** will receive:

1. Payment of standard school contributions and charges for 2010
2. \$300 Voucher from Wooldridges
3. A school uniform courtesy of Nell Gray Manufacturing.
4. An **Australian School of the Year Scholarship** certificate.

CONDITIONS

1. The decision of the school in respect to the naming of the winner of the *Australian School of the Year Scholarship* is final.
2. Applicants must live and continue to live with their parents at an address within our Local Intake Area.
3. The winner, through the authority of their parents, will agree to appear in any publicity that Rossmoyne Senior High School seeks and receives as a consequence of the *Australian School of the Year Scholarship*. This may include publicity in our school newsletter and web site, local, state and national press announcements, and television and radio coverage.
4. The Scholarship is for Year 8 only.
5. The winner of the scholarship will be expected to abide by the School's Behaviour Management Policy and School Dress Code.
6. The school reserves the right to withdraw the scholarship at any time during its duration in the event of a serious breach of any of these conditions.
