### More Apprenticeships, Traineeships and Pre-apprenticeships

The McGowan Government has negotiated for Western Australia, to get up to \$126 million from the Commonwealth Skilling Australians Fund National Partnership, to create jobs for apprenticeships, traineeships and pre-apprenticeships.

It is not clear if that is subsidies to employ and train new staff, or more advice but no real jobs.

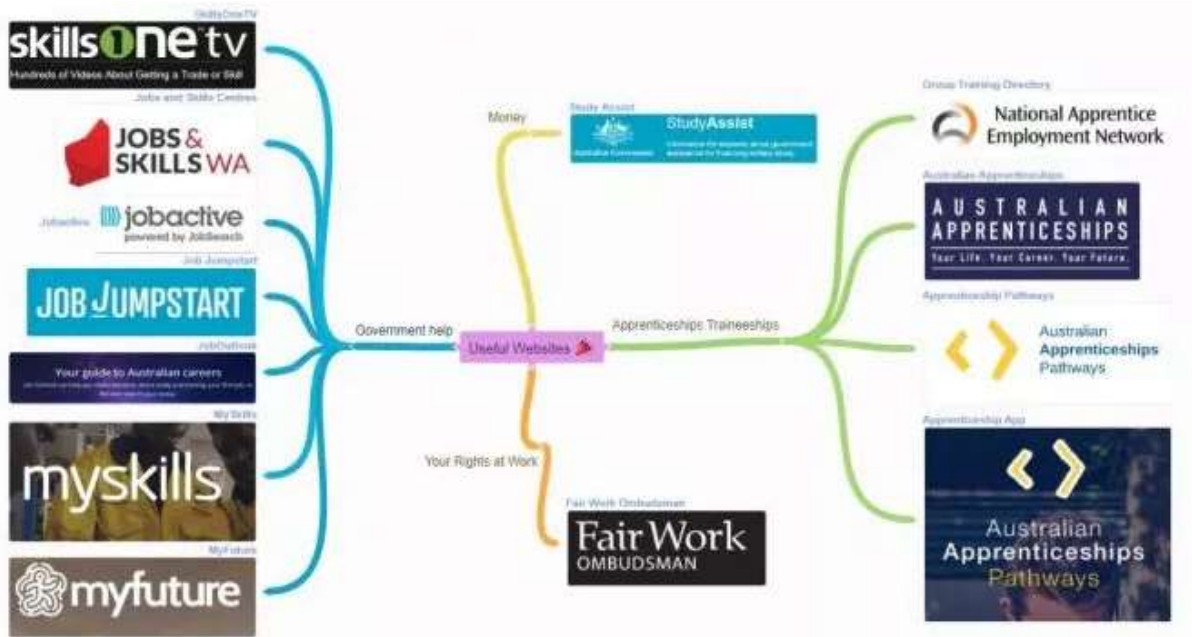
